Assignment of Mentees to Mentors

- Students shall be assigned mentors at the commencement of the session. In most cases, it has been ensured that the mentor is a subject teacher.
- The faculty mentor for a mentee remains unchanged for the FYUGP (Four-Year Undergraduate Programme).
- Please refer to the circular relating to the assignment of mentees to mentors.

Role of a Faculty Mentor

Your role as a mentor is a mix of friend and teacher. Relationships developed with your mentees become channels for the passage of information, advice, challenges, opportunities, and support, with the ultimate goals of facilitating achievement and having fun.


As a mentor you offer the following:

- (a) Information**
Mentors share their knowledge, experiences, and wisdom.
- (b) Contacts**
Mentors provide valuable opportunities by facilitating academic, career, and personal contacts.
- (c) Opportunities and Challenges**
Mentors stimulate curiosity and build confidence by presenting new ideas, opportunities, and challenges.
- (d) Support**
Mentors encourage growth and achievement by providing an open and supportive environment.
- (e) Goal Setting**
Mentors help mentees discover talents and interests and define and attain their goals.
- (f) Advice**
Mentors guide mentees in reaching academic, career, and personal goals.
- (g) Role Models**
By sharing stories of achievement with mentees, mentors can become role models.

As a mentor you should:

- (a) Hold *a minimum of two meetings per semester* with the mentees.
- (b) The agenda of the first meeting with new students (first-year students) must include the following points:
 - ✓ Students' Data Collection
 - ✓ WhatsApp Group Formation (Facilitated by IT Cell)
 - ✓ Attendance & Code of Conduct
 - ✓ Clarity in the choice of Electives
 - ✓ Enrollment in NCC, NSS, and other student bodies.
 - ✓ Scholarship, Fee waiver & Grievance Mechanism
 - ✓ Any Other
- (c) Update the student information sheet(format enclosed) at least once in every semester.
- (d) Maintain confidentiality of personal information of the mentee, and records of the meeting which is to be maintained by the mentor.
- (e) Establish rapport and maintain regular communication with mentees.
- (f) Recognize mentees' strengths and weaknesses and give them constructive feedback.

Electronic communication eliminates the challenges imposed by time, distance, and disability that are characteristic of in-person mentoring. Frequent electronic communications and personal contacts bring participants together with mentors to facilitate academic, career, and personal achievements.
