Event Guidelines Role Play – "Campus Mein Samanta"

Role Play Theme: Promoting Equality and Inclusion in Campus Life

Objective:

To create awareness, initiate dialogue, and showcase everyday scenarios where gender roles, stereotypes, and inequality manifest in college life — and how they can be challenged or transformed.

1. Eligibility:

- Open to teams of Intermediate, UG, and PG students from all streams.
- Each team must have **3 to 4 participants**.
- **Mixed-gender teams are encouraged.**

2. Duration:

- Each performance should be between **3 to 5 minutes** (including setup and exit).

3. Language:

- Hindi, English, or bilingual.
- Use of local/regional expressions is allowed for relatability.

4. Content Focus:

- Scenarios may include (but are not limited to):
 - Classroom participation
 - Sports inclusion
 - Library/lab access
 - Dress code rules
 - Leadership opportunities
 - Peer interaction
 - Staff-student treatment
 - **Any other theme relevant to gender equality and inclusion in campus life**
- Each act should **highlight a challenge** related to gender equity or inclusion and offer a **solution or transformative message**.

5. Props and Costumes:

- Simple props and costumes may be used.
- Teams must arrange their own and ensure **quick setup/removal**.
- Avoid items that are **offensive, culturally inappropriate, or unsafe**.

7. Do's and Don'ts:

- DO keep the script **respectful and inclusive**
- DON'T use **discriminatory language, sexist humour, or offensive stereotypes**
- DON'T exceed the time limit or use music/sound without **prior approval**

8. Registration:

- Interested teams must register by **27.07.2025**.
- Submit:
 - **Team name**
 - **Number of participants**
 - **A 3-line concept note**

9. Preliminary Screening:

- Will be held on **29.07.2025**.
- **Selected performances** will be showcased during the **final event** on **01.08.2025**.

Recognition and Prizes

- **First Prize** – Best Role Play (Overall)
- **Second Prize** – Best Message for Inclusion
- **Third Prize** – Best Team Coordination
- **Special Mention** – Original Concept
